#### Impact Notes

- Scott hosted a 7-week, 7 Speaker Series to expose students to different career, college, and life skills opportunities
- Riverside hosted a "Pastries with Partners" event to solicit and inform new partnerships. Several new partnerships were formed, including a nearly \$7,000 donation to support Hub programming for students.
- Reynolds Hub celebrated classrooms who met iReady goals and supported teachers with additional planning time.
- Rogers assembled a Healing Coalition with nearly 20 engaged community partners committed to supporting the Rogers community in being more trauma- and grief-sensitive.

#### Other Impact Notes

- Community Discoveries underway in all Hub communities. Town Halls expected in Fall 2023.
- Hub Happenings launched in January 2023. Issues released monthly.
- Jones Leadership Academy of Business and Pickett Academy are expected to become full-service Hubs in July 2023.
- All Hubs represented in the national Community Schools x Family Engagement conference facilitated through Institute for Educational Leadership (IEL) and the Coalition for Community Schools. Hub leaders led a successful workshop for approximately 50 participants..



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### Legend

- Participants = this could include students, staff, families, or community members, depending on the event
- School events = these are events that are school centered with the purpose of sharing information and/or fostering connectedness between participants. This could include Parent and Community Power Hours, family engagement events, or other community wide events (Trunk-or-Treat, tailgates, Touch-a-Truck, etc).
- Health Promotion events = these events are focused on sharing information about available resources that promote improved physical or mental health. Examples include mental health first aid training, health fairs, and CPR training for community residents.
- Community Workshops = these events center on skill-building in content areas identified as priorities by the community. This could include financial coaching, parenting classes, or literacy nights.
