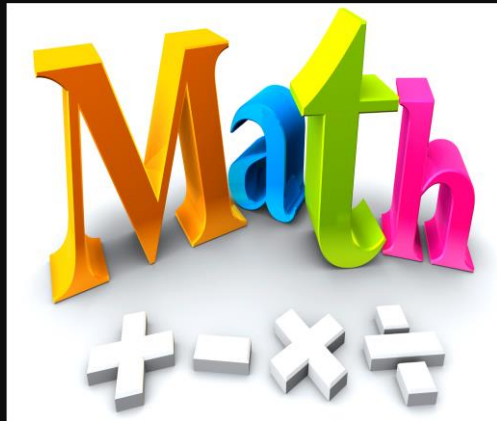


Helping Your Child

Parents can help influence students' math skills. Math is present every time you:

- Sort objects
- Compare prices

Activities

- ✧ Let your child help with cooking by measuring the ingredients and checking cooking times and temperatures. Older children can increase or decrease recipes.
- ✧ Have your child figure out how to cut a pizza, cake, pie or sandwich for different numbers of people.
- ✧ Have your child practice, record, and read the larger number on license plates viewed while in the car. Find the largest number in a given time period of travel.
- ✧ Have your child use street maps to find travel routes and addresses. Estimate the time of your arrival and compare that to the actual time it took to arrive at a given destination.
