Dear Elementary School Parents and Guardians:

As you know, the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) requires students beginning in Grade 3 to take part in a spring State test. These tests are The Ohio's State Tests (OSTs). If your student is on an IEP, which indicates he/she takes the Alternate State test, which is created specifically for students with special needs, they will have already tested in February-March 2019.

Per ODE:

State achievement tests tell us how well our students are growing in the knowledge and skills outlined in Ohio's Learning Standards. These tests help guide and strengthen future teaching so we can be sure that we are preparing our students for long-term success in school, college, careers and life. Test results also allow citizens to know how their local schools are performing compared to others around the state (education.ohio.gov/Topics/Testing/Ohios-State-Test-in-ELA-Math-Science-SocialStudies).
