

## Mrs. Kaufman's 2019-2020 Kindergarten Supply List

### Hawkins Elementary

The following will be community items to be shared, and do not need your child's name marked on it:

- 2 boxes (24 count) Crayola Crayons
- 1 box Crayola Broad-line markers (10 count)
- 8 glue sticks
- 1 container Clorox disinfecting wipes
