

# 2019-2020 Dress Code

To this end, the Academy, adopted a dress code standard that not only was different from other “traditional” elementary schools, but also stands apart from the Board adopted dress code.

Therefore, the official dress code is as follows:

## **Kindergarten – 2<sup>nd</sup> Grades:**

- khaki slacks
- khaki skirt/skort/jumper/bermuda shorts
- **\*\*burgundy plaid skirt/skort/jumper\*\***

## **3<sup>rd</sup> Grades – 6<sup>th</sup> Grades**

- **NO SLACKS**
- khaki skirt/skort/jumper
- **\*\*burgundy plaid skirt/skort/jumper\*\***

## **Tops (with a collar):**

- **ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES**
- burgundy, light pink, dark pink, or navy blouse/polo
- **No other colors or prints may be worn under shirts.**

## **Knee Socks/Tights:**

- **ABSOLUTELY NO LEGGINGS**
- burgundy, navy, pink or white

## **Accessories:**

- **\*\*burgundy or burgundy plaid cross tie\*\***
- burgundy or navy cardigan/vest
- **ABSOLUTELY NO HOODIES**
- **ABSOLUTELY NO LEGGINGS**

## **Dress Shoes (dark colored):**

- **solid black, brown, burgundy or navy dress shoes are required**
- solid white or solid black tennis shoes for Physical Education (no light up, bling, or high tops)
- Tennis shoes are to be worn for Phys. Ed. Only. Students must change back into dress shoes.
- No outside winter boots may be worn during the school day. Students must bring dress shoes to change into if boots are worn to school.
