Excellent Attendance! Being in school every day, and on time, means your child won't miss out on learning. Try to schedule appointments and family trips outside of the school hours. If she asks to stay home "just because," remind her of what she'll miss, such as her reading group or PE class. Explain that she can be absent only if she is sick or if there's a family emergency.

The August/September core value is RESPECT. What does respect look like? Your youngster's daily dealings with adults and kids alike will be more pleasant if she speaks and acts respectfully. Try this tip for helping her learn about respect. Think about something that you and your youngster disagree on (say, whether her video game time should be limited). Model having a respectful discussion about it. You might say that her brain and body are growing and that she needs to run and play to stay healthy. Then, suggest a respectful response, such as, "I want to be healthy, but I love video games." Have her brainstorm other situations where people have different opinions but still speak to each other with respect.

The traits of **RESPECT** are:

1. **self-respect**- "Respect yourself and others will respect you."
2. **tolerance**- "Together we can do great things."
3. **kindness**- "Be the change you wish to see in the world."
4. **cooperation**- "Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much."
5. **helpfulness**- "Never look down on someone unless you are helping them up."

Words to live by: "I do what is right, not what is easy."
