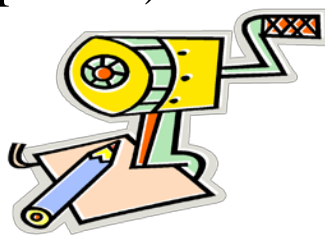

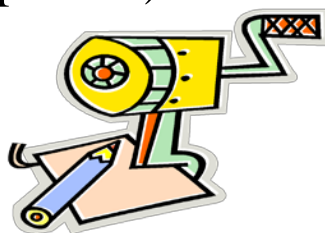

Hello, and welcome to 5th Grade! Here's the supply plan: children's markers, colored pencils, and crayons will be put in baggies with their name on the bag. Glue sticks and scissors will be in bins to be passed out when needed for an activity. This cuts down on students being distracted as well as the overuse of supplies.

1. three-ring binder

- zipper kind is preferred, about 1 to 2 inches thick. They will only hold a folder, 1 pack of paper, and a pencil pouch.
- I have seen one on Amazon for as low \$11.64. The zipper binders keep everything together.

2. notebook paper, loose leaf, 1 packet

- the wide-ruled paper-put it in their binder

3. one folder with three holes

- (Please label the insides: 1. **Keep at HOME** 2. **Return to SCHOOL**

4. 4 spiral notebooks,

- labeled in LARGE letters, in marker, on the front: **Math, E.L.A., Social Studies** and

Science. Student's names should also be written on the front of each.

- These will be kept on a shelf in the classroom, so labels matter.

5. 40 pencils, ___(Yes, students really need that many. Pre-sharpened are nice. Ticonderoga are the best!)

6. Cloth pencil pouch with holes (to put into a binder)

7. Markers, WASHABLE, 8 or more ___

8. Markers, DRY-ERASE, 8 or more ___(Do not get the 2-in-1 markers, they dry out quickly)

9. Clean washcloth ___ (a dark color, these will be used to erase dry-erase boards)

15. Hand sanitizer, bottle size, _(I will store these and put a few out around the room for all to use.)

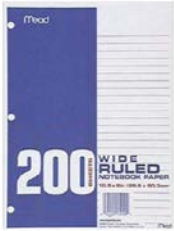
