## **Whittier 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>h</sup> Grade Behavior Plan**

Dear Parents and Students:

7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teachers will utilize Classroom Dojo for all students. All teachers will be linked to each student and will be able to give them positive and constructive feedback throughout the day. As a parent/guardian, you will be able to sign up through Classroom Dojo to monitor your child's behavior.

The 7<sup>h</sup> and 8<sup>h</sup> grade rules are as follows and are in conjunction with the rules stated in the Whittier Elementary Student/Parent Handbook.

1. Be on time and prepared with all supplies in full uniform
2. Be respectful of others and school property (i.e. excessive talking, talking back to adult, vandalism)
3. No Personal Electronic Use
4. No food or drink (except lunch)
5. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself

Consequences for not following the rules will result in a verbal warning, if repeated; the student will receive a "needs work" Dojo point. If behavior continues, another "needs work " Dojo point will be given, followed by a lunch detention or after school detention. **\*Severe behavior can result in an immediate detention or referral being written.**

**Parents will be given a 24-hour notice when students have to serve an after school detention. Detention time is 3:30-4:00 PM after school on select days.**

Positive behavior Dojo points will be given to students for demonstrating positive behavior. These points, to be used for rewards, may be cashed in at the end of the week.

Students will be made aware of the requirements to earn rewards. Rewards range from small items to quarterly parties.

Due to a large amount of vandalism in the 2017-2018 school year, students will not be allowed to have sharpie/permanent markers in the classroom or on them. These markers will be confiscated if seen. Washable markers are acceptable. Teachers will have permanent markers when necessary.
